

Matific Global Cup: Terms & Conditions

This competition is organized by Slate Science Operations Pty Ltd, located in Level 3, 447 Kent Street, Sydney NSW 2000.

1. Campaign Scope and Duration

The MatificGlobal Cup global competition is scheduled to run for exactly four weeks, starting on June 22nd and concluding on July 19th. The campaign operates strictly at the country level to ensure a streamlined competition.

2. Participation and Representation

Participation is open to existing Matific schools and new schools (who may access Matific as a trial or paid license during the event) and all Matific students. Teachers explicitly represent their respective schools and students. Parents explicitly represent their children.

Participants from the top 3 ranked countries become eligible for prize draws.

All participants must be verified as active participants to qualify for the raffle and award processes.

3. Scoring and Leaderboard Mechanics

- Students earn coins by completing Matific maths activities during the competition period.
- Coins can be used to unlock limited time football outfits in the Matific Global Cup Shop.
- Points are awarded for every football outfit unlocked during the competition period.
- The competition is conducted at the country level.
- Country rankings are adjusted based on the number of active Matific students in each participating country between 22 June and 19 July. This adjustment helps ensure countries of different sizes can compete fairly on the leaderboard.
- To be counted, students must have logged into Matific at least once during the competition period and purchased one or more event outfits.

- Each outfit purchased contributes **10 points** to the student's country's total score. The more outfits purchased and points earned by participating students, the higher their country will rank on the leaderboard.
- To promote fair competition, leaderboard scores are weighted according to the number of active Matific students in each participating country. This ensures that countries with significantly different student populations have a more balanced opportunity to compete.
- For schools to be eligible for prizes minimum 30% students must participate.
- Leaderboard rankings for the countries are updated throughout the competition period.
- Matific reserves the right to review and verify participation data before confirming final rankings.

4. Awards and Prizes

- Countries will compete for a place in the Top 3 positions on the leaderboard.
- Eligible participants from the Top 3 countries will be entered into prize draws.
 - Three (3) schools will each receive a USD \$500 school voucher.
 - Three (3) students will each receive a USD \$100 prize.
- Three (3) Instagram Selfie Lottery winners will each receive a USD \$100 prize.
- All winners will be selected through a random lottery draw from eligible entries.
- Winners will be announced on July 24, 2026.
- Matific's decision regarding winner selection is final.

5. Social Media Contest

Participants may enter an additional social media contest by completing the following steps in order:

1. Customize a Matific Global Cup avatar.
2. Share a picture of your customized avatar.
3. Follow @matific, @matificlatam, or @matificbr on Instagram.
4. Post the image on Instagram using #matificglobalcup.
5. Tag @matific, @matificlatam, or @matificbr in the post.
6. Eligible entries will be entered into a random draw for one of three (3) USD \$100 prizes.

Participants who complete all of the above steps will be eligible to enter the prize draw.

Prizes: Three (3) vouchers valued at USD 100 each.
